**Construction Contractors Board Issues Emergency License
Suspension of Portland Area Contractor**

On July 2, 2006, the Construction Contractors Board (CCB) issued an emergency suspension to Rob's Custom Interiors, Inc. of Portland directing the business to immediately cease construction contractor activities. Rob's Custom Interiors, Inc. is operating in the Manzanita and Rockaway Beach area.

The corporate officers of Rob's Custom Interiors, Inc. are Robert D. Moore of Portland and Bradley L. Thomas of West Linn.

Moore and Thomas each have previous CCB licenses with outstanding construction debt. Moore's dispute resolution debt is over \$5000 and Thomas owes more than \$13,000 in civil penalties.

The CCB may suspend a license without hearing if there are sufficient findings that there is a serious danger to the public welfare, including conduct as a construction contractor that is dishonest or fraudulent.

The CCB is a state agency licensing more than 43,000 contractors. Anyone who is paid to repair, improve or build a home must be licensed by the CCB. Consumers can verify a contractor's license and find information for successful projects at www.oregon.gov/CCB or by calling 503-378-4621.
